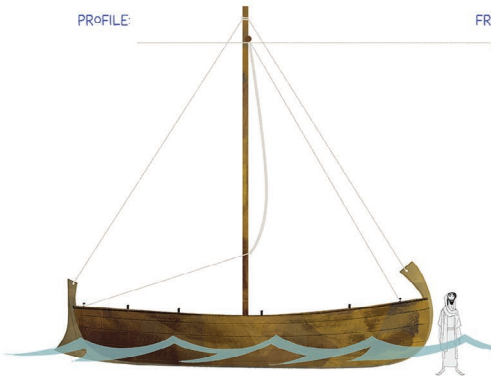
James is set to inherit his father's business, but when Jesus calls him to leave his nets and become a fisher of men, he doesn't hesitate.



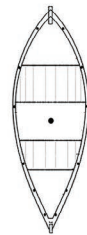
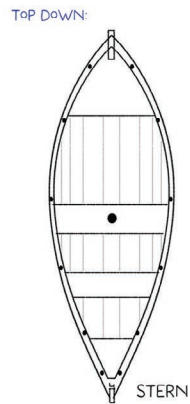

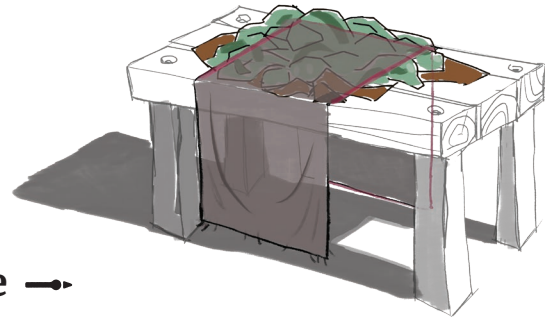
Mary Magdalene is a tortured woman with a dark past. She made many bad decisions. But when she encounters Jesus, he delivers her from darkness, and she never looks back.

← Caiaphas' Home →



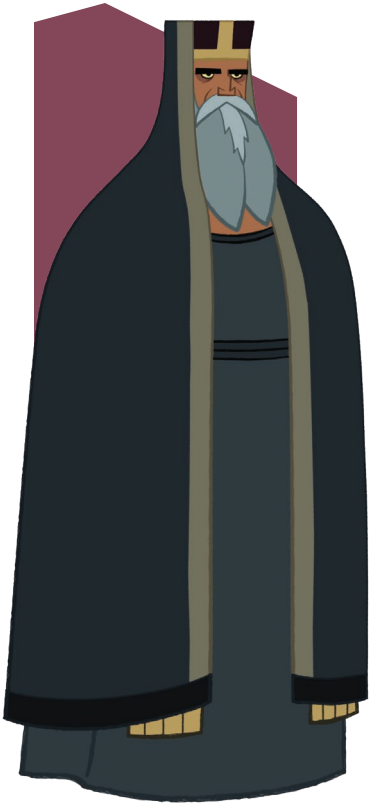

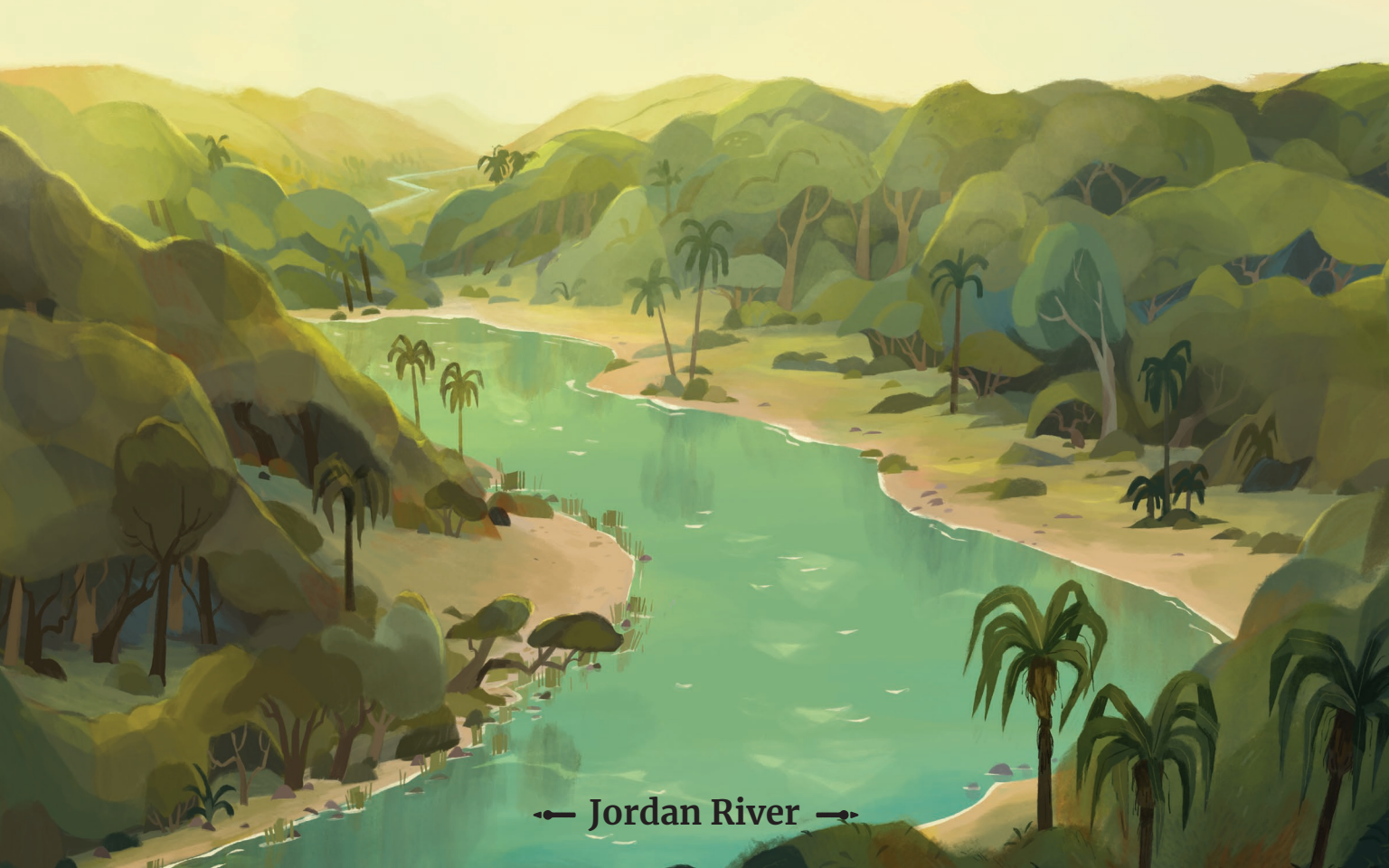

Mary loves her son and dotes on him, perhaps because she knows that she is destined to lose him. "And a sword will pierce your very soul." Luke 2:35

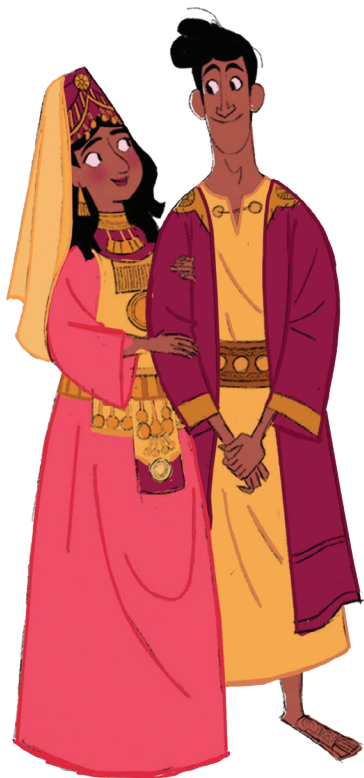

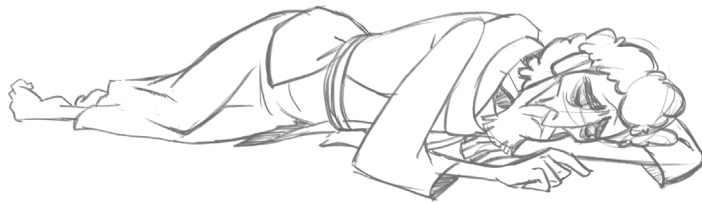


← Lowering the Paralytic →

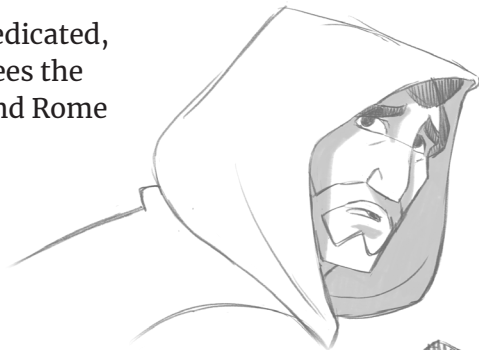

reduced to rubble.



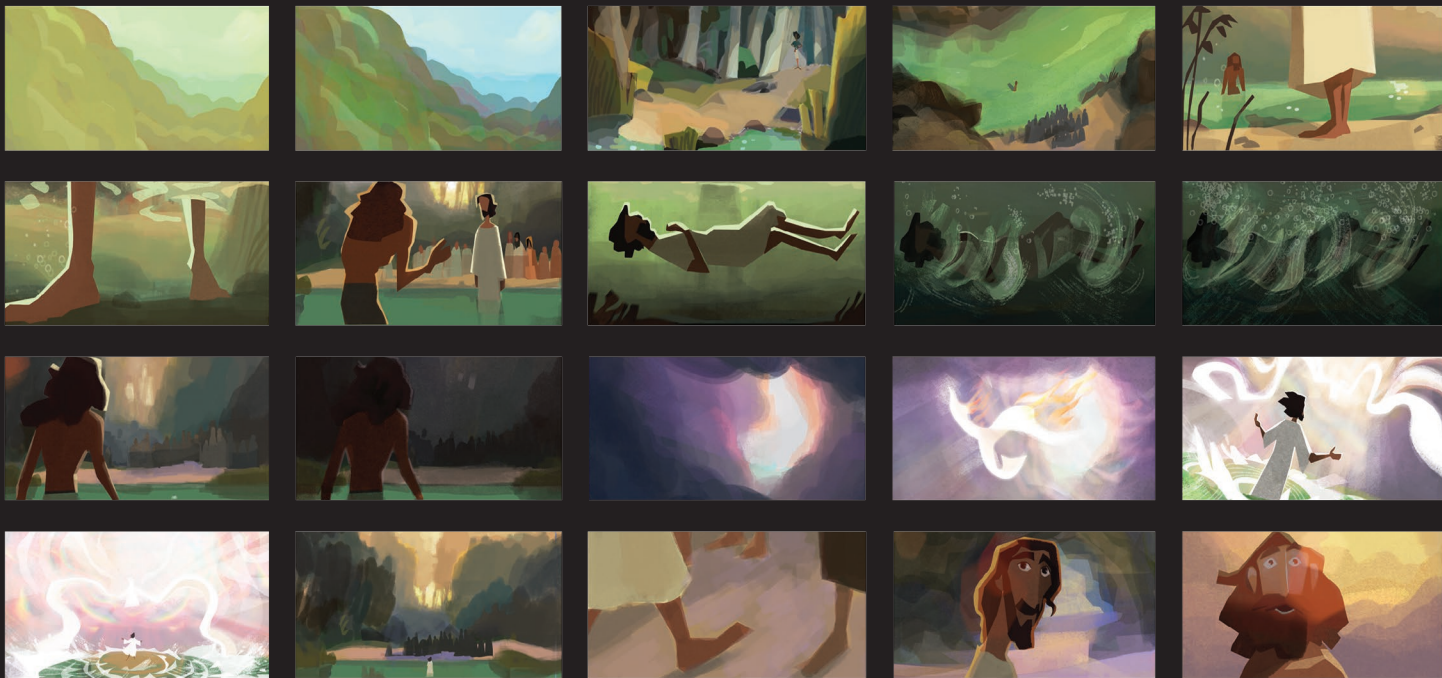
